Care of Central Venous Access Devices (excluding renal lines)

This competency record is to assess and record the evidence of an individual's clinical competence and supervised practice working with Central Venous Access Devices (CVAD). Staff must have read the Guideline G004 and completed the CVAD LearnPro module or have attended a face to face teaching session prior to having their practice assessed and supervised in order to work with CVADs independently. Reflection of one's own practice and learning needs is integral to maintaining clinical skills and knowledge in current practice and should be reviewed annually as part of the PDR / eKSF process and NMC revalidation process.
