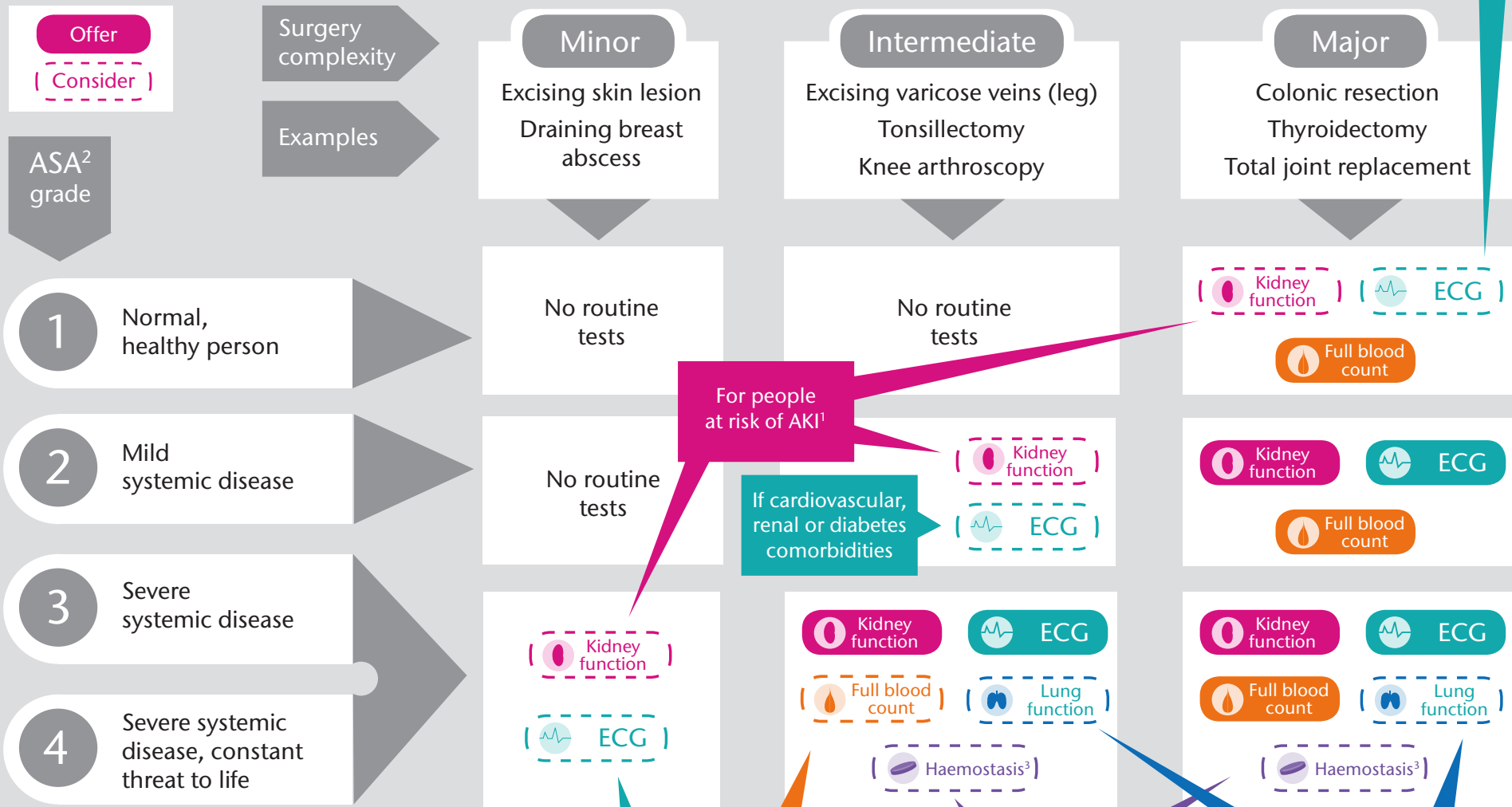


Recommended tests before elective surgery

¹ Acute kidney injury - people at risk include:

- Intraperitoneal surgery
- eGFR < 60ml/min/1.73m²
- Diabetes
- Heart failure
- Age 65 years+
- Liver disease
- Use of drugs with nephrotoxic potential in the perioperative period

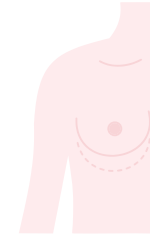
³ Tests such as (Activated) Partial Thromboplastin Time (APTT or PTT), and platelets

LFT

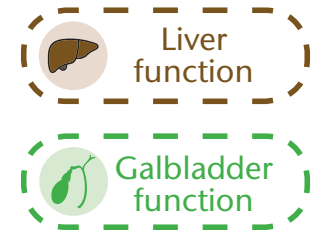
Suspected malignancy
